# Middlesex Grand Officers' and Provincial Grand Officers' Club

## Rules

### 1. **Name**

The Name of the Club shall be the Middlesex Grand Officers' and Provincial Grand Officers Club, also known as the Middlesex Provincial Grand Officers' Club.

### 2. **Object**

The object of the Club is to associate Grand Officers who are members of Middlesex Lodges and Middlesex Provincial Grand Officers with the management of the Masonic Province of Middlesex, by providing opportunities for two-way communication between the Provincial Executive and those Officers and through the latter to members of their Lodges

### 3. **Membership**

Membership of the Club shall be open to Grand Officers, Provincial Grand Officers of the Province of Middlesex and other Provinces, District Grand Officers and holders of Overseas Grand Rank, Overseas Rank, Senior London Grand Rank, London Grand Rank and London Rank, who are in good standing in a Middlesex Lodge or Middlesex Royal Arch Chapter and who shall have applied for membership of the Club and paid such dues as may be determined from time to time as provided below.

### 4. **Management**

The Management of the Club shall be undertaken by a Committee consisting of a President, who shall be the Provincial Grand Master or Pro Provincial Grand Master, a Deputy President, who shall be the Deputy Provincial Grand Master, both serving ex-officio, a Secretary and a Treasurer who shall be elected annually on the nomination of the President or, in his absence, the Deputy President. The Committee shall have powers to co-opt or consult as it thinks fit.

### 5. **Business**

The Club will normally meet twice a year as determined by the Committee to enable the President to inform members of the state of Freemasonry in the Province and of any problems or major developments under consideration; and also to provide an opportunity for members to raise any matters, which they consider of importance for the Province generally. Such matters shall be notified to the Secretary of the Club not less than three weeks before a meeting, so that the President may give proper consideration to them.

### 6. **Finance**

The administrative costs of the Club shall be met by an annual subscription payable by each member as determined by the Committee; until further notice the rate of subscription shall be £5 per annum. Accounts made up to 31<sup>st</sup> December each year shall be presented for adoption at the first meeting of the Club after that date. These accounts shall first be audited by auditors nominated and elected annually by members. Unless and until the Committee decides otherwise, the Club's Bankers shall be Barclays Bank PLC, Ealing and Greenford Business Centre, 53 The Broadway, London W5 5JS. The signature of one member of the Committee shall suffice to authorise cheques not exceeding £200. Two signatures shall be necessary for sums in excess of that amount.

### 7. **Rules**

Changes to these rules may be made at any meeting of the Club on a proposition by the President or, in his absence the Deputy President.
